1. Australian Sailing registration. This is required for any member who is active and allows you to participate in club and association racing. Membership provides personal accident insurance while participating in an official club or association on water event. NOTE: Once you are registered and paid your fee you may find your membership number by visiting the website at <https://sailing.org.au/member-finder/> This number will need to be placed in the box provided on the front page of this form.
2. Members are expected to be available for rostered duties as well as club busy bees.
3. Storing a boat at the club is in addition to membership and must be approved by the PBYC committee. This is subject to available space. Priority is given to members actively Involved in the sailing activities.
4. Members using the boat ramp must have full membership. This facility is not available to social or non active bar and recreation members.
